MAINTAINING OF THE NDRRMOC ALERT STATUS TO

BLUE ICOW THE LA NIÑA-LIKE CONDITIONS, KANLAON

VOLCANO ACTIVITY, AND TRASLACION 2025

Based on the latest Climate Outlook, La Niña-like conditions persist in the tropical Pacific, influencing weather patterns in the country. At present, the Philippines is experiencing the effects of three (3) distinct weather systems: Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in MIMAROPA, parts of region V, Visayas, and Mindanao; Shear Line in II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, and the rest of region V; and the Northeast Monsoon in CAR, I, and NCR.

In addition, the Feast of the **Black Nazarene** (**Traslacion 2025**) scheduled this January is expected to draw a significant influx of devotees, requiring intensified monitoring and crowd management efforts to ensure public safety.

Meanwhile, the continued alert status and activity of **Kanlaon Volcano** remain under close observation. Residents and local authorities are advised to stay vigilant and follow updates from relevant agencies to mitigate potential risks.

In this regard, the following shall be implemented:

- Maintaining of the Alert Status of the NDRRMOC to BLUE ICOW the La Niña-like conditions, Kanlaon Volcano Activity, and Traslacion 2025.
- 2. Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from AFP, BFP, PCG, and PNP, are required to continue their in-person duty at the NDRRMOC.

Likewise, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and RDRRMCs are required to continue monitoring, join the virtual EOC, and to send preparedness measures and updates thru our NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard, email address: ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, telephone numbers.: 8912-5668, 8912-3046; and/or facsimile number.: 8911-1873.
