AND REGIONAL DRRM COUNCILS

SUBJECT: Raising of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and

Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert Status from WHITE to BLUE effective 06 June 2025 ICOW Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Guiuan, Eastern Visayas

Based on the Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) Scenario Building conducted on 06 June 2025 at 9:00 AM, the LPA was estimated at 640 km East of Guiuan, Eastern Visayas (11.5° N, 131.6° E) and has a moderate likelihood of development into a Tropical Depression within 24 hours, while the Southwest Monsoon is affecting Luzon and the western sections of Visayas and Mindanao. Therefore, the alert status at the NDRRMOC is hereby raised from WHITE to BLUE effective 06 June 2025, 3:00 PM to closely monitor, consolidate, and to ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices.

Likewise, the Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from the **AFP**, **BFP**, **PCG** and **PNP** are hereby required to render duty at the NDRRMOC to ensure uninterrupted coordination and to facilitate requests, and address concerns pertinent to your respective agencies.

Furthermore, all OCDROs / Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operation Centers (RDRRMOCs) are hereby directed to closely monitor, consolidate, and report all related incidents and to ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices. Accordingly, a **virtual Emergency Operations Center (EOC)** shall be activated to facilitate more efficient coordination.

Preparedness measures, respective response action plans, and any untoward incidents monitored regarding the said event shall be submitted through the NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard. Likewise, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies are directed to ensure continuous monitoring and to send preparedness measures and updates to the NDRRMOC thru email address at ndrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, telephone numbers: 8912-5668, 8912-3046; and/or facsimile number: 8911-1873.
