TO : NATIONAL RESPONSE CLUSTER LEADS AND MEMBERS

SUBJECT : ACTIVATION OF NATIONAL RESPONSE CLUSTERS and NATIONAL INTER-AGENCY COORDINATING CELL ICOW TROPICAL CYCLONE "CRISING" and SOUTHWEST MONSOON.

The center of Tropical Depression (TD) CRISING was estimated based on all available data at 535 km East of Juban, Sorsogon (13.1°N, 128.9°E), with maximum sustained winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 70 km/h. Moving West Northwestward at 15 km/h and is currently enhancing the Southwest Monsoon.

In view of this, the following National Response Clusters are hereby **activated or on standby** effective **July 17, 2025, 12:00 NN** for emergency response and humanitarian assistance:

Activated:

1. Logistics (OCD)
2. Food and Non-Food Items (DSWD)
3. Search, Rescue and Retrieval (AFP)
4. Health (DOH)
5. Law and Order (PNP)
6. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (DSWD)
7. Internally Displaced Persons Protection (DSWD)
8. Crisis Communications (PCO-PIA)
9. Education (DepEd)
10. Emergency Telecommunications (DICT)

On Standby:

1. Philippine International Humanitarian Assistance (DFA)
2. Management of Dead and Missing (DILG)
3. Early Recovery (OCD)
4. Debris Clearing and Civil Works (DPWH)
5. Shelter (DHSUD)

All concerned Cluster Lead Agencies are directed to continue monitoring response at regional and local levels, providing augmentation support for TD CRISING and Southwest Monsoon.


