AND REGIONAL DRRM COUNCILS**

**SUBJECT : Downgrading of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and
Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert Status
from RED to BLUE ICOW the Combined Effects of
Southwest Monsoon and Tropical Cyclones (TCs)
"CRISING", "DANTE", and "EMONG" effective 04 August
2025, 5:00 PM**

In consideration of the situation updates, the heightened monitoring of the NDRRMOC shall be downgraded from **RED to BLUE** effective **04 August 2025, 5:00 PM** in view of the following factors:

1. The mentioned Tropical Cyclones are no longer affecting the country.
2. IACC was deactivated effective 31 July 2025, 5:00 PM.
3. The situation is manageable at the regional level.

However, Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from **AFP, BFP, PCG, and PNP** are still required to render duty at the NDRRMOC. Further, the Virtual Emergency Operations Center (via Zoom) shall no longer remain active on a continuous basis but may be reactivated as necessary for coordination. All concerned regional offices, agencies and other stakeholders shall be duly notified of any reactivation.

Likewise, the NDRRMOC shall continuously monitor the situation in the country and maintain close coordination with relevant offices. Thus, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and Regional DRRMCs are still required to continue monitoring and submit updates on the current and recent disaster events to the NDRRMOC thru the **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**, email address ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, and telephone/facsimile nrs.: **8911-1406, 8912-2665, and 8911-1873.**
