SUBJECT :

Maintaining of the BLUE Alert Status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) ICOW the Low Pressure Area (LPA 8a)

and the Southwest Monsoon

Based from the Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) Scenario Building meeting conducted on 07 August 2025 at 1:00 PM, the LPA 08a East of Casiguran Aurora and LPA 08b East of Northern Luzon is likely to develop into a Tropical Cyclone, while Southwest Monsoon affecting Palawan, Visayas, and Mindanao. In view of this, the alert status at the NDRRMOC is maintained to BLUE Alert to closely monitor, consolidate, and to ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices.

Further, Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from AFP, BFP, PCG, and PNP are still required to render duty at the NDRRMOC. Likewise, the NDRRMOC shall continuously monitor the situation in the country and maintain close coordination with concerned offices. Thus, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and Regional DRRMCs are still required to continue monitoring and submit updates on the current and recent disaster events to the NDRRMOC thru the NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard, email address: ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, and telephone/facsimile nrs.: 8911-1406, 8912-2665, and 8911-1873.
