OVERVIEW	On July 5, 2025, a fire incident occurred at Block 27 A&C and Block 29 Baltaw Street, Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City. Per BFP-NCR, fire started at around 11:21 am and was declared fire out at 3:49 pm. The cause of fire is under investigation.

#### **OFFICE OF CIVIL DEFENSE – NCR**

## **DSWD FO NCR**

- The DSWD FO- NCR through the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) has Conducted field monitoring on July 5, 2025.
