OVERVIEW	Based on PAGASA's weather forecast on July 05, 2025 at 05:00 PM, Zamboanga Peninsula will have cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms due to the Southwest Monsoon (Habagat). Possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains. Light to moderate winds from southwest to south with slight to moderate seas (0.6 to 2.1 meters).

# **Region 9**

## DSWD FO IX

- Conducted profiling and assessment in the affected barangays;

- DSWD Field Office IX is continuously coordinating with the CSWDO of Zamboanga City for disaggregated data of families, additional relief assistance and augmentation needed by the affected families.

# LGU Zamboanga City

- Immediately responded to the affected areas;
- Distributed food packs, water and other relief goods to the affected families and individuals;
- Continuous monitoring of water level at Tumaga River;
- Continuous information dissemination of weather advisories via social media

# OCD IX

- Upon receipt of the report, OCD IX Emergency Operations Center immediately coordinated with the Zamboanga City DRRM Office for the details of the said report;

- OCD IX EOC is closely coordinating with Zamboanga City DRRMO for any significant disaster response updates and issues that may need immediate action;

- Continuous monitoring on the effects of Southwest Monsoon (SWM) and other Weather Disturbances that may affect the region.
