## Manila DRRMO

-Deployment and Response Efforts

-Manila DRRM Office deployed a fire suppression team (2) firetruck: Angel Tanker 4, Angel Tanker 5 -Manila DRRM Office deployed a medical team (2) Ambulance: Covid 1, LC3 to take immediate action if there are any patients who need to be treated.

-Manila DRRM Office personnel have been deployed for information gathering.

Coordination:

-Manila DRRM Office coordinated with the Bureau of Fire Protection Manila Fire District (BFP-MFD).

-Fire volunteers have been alerted to take appropriate response actions.

-Upon monitoring through radio as per advised by the BFP ground

Monitoring

-At 0506H, Emergency Operations Center monitors a reported fire at Galicia Street corner Sulucan Street Sampaloc, Manila. through radio.

-At 0508H, 1st Alarm was raised.

-Close monitoring is being conducted at the Manila DRRM Office – Operations Center.

-Monitor the fire incident through radio and social media to identify and provide the resources needed to support the fire suppression operation.

-Continuously coordinating with the personnel on scene for further details of the fire incident.

-At 0510H, 2nd Alarm was raised.

-At 0520H, 3rd Alarm was raised.

-At 0530H, 4th Alarm was raised.

-Continuously monitoring through radio and social media to identify and provide the resources needed to support the fire suppression operation.

-At 0657H, Fire is now Under Control.

-Fire Out as of 0808H.
