OVERVIEW	<p>On or about 5:20PM, 15 April 2025, the MV "Hong Hai 16", a sand carrier vessel owned by Keen Peak Corporation, with 25 crew members onboard (13 Filipinos and 12 Chinese Nationals) reportedly capsized approximately one-hundred (100) meters off the shoreline of Barangay Malawaan, Rizal, Occidental Mindoro.</p> <p>The capsized vessel has a gross tonnage of 9,994 and a net tonnage of 3,002. It was carrying approximately 2,000 liters of lube oil and 30,000 liters of Automotive Diesel Oil (ADO).</p> <p>The incident was reported via phone call to Coast Guard Sub Station San Jose, Occidental Mindoro from a staff of Bantay Dagat Rizal.</p>
