**Initial Report for the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Region XII**

OVERVIEW	<p>From April 27 to May 1, 2025, several weather-related incidents were reported in various parts of Region XII due to persistent rainfall associated with the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).</p> <p>On April 27, 2025, at approximately 1:00 PM, Barangay Napnapon in Palimbang, Sultan Kudarat experienced a flash flood triggered by heavy rains brought by the ITCZ. Two days later, at around 4:30 PM on April 29, continuous heavy rainfall occurred in Bagumbayan, Sultan Kudarat, which resulted in flooding in Barangays Poblacion and Biwang. Reports confirmed that there were no casualties or evacuations during this incident.</p> <p>On April 30, 2025, at around 1:30 PM, light to moderate rainfall was observed in Maitum, Sarangani. This caused flooding in nine barangays and a landslide along the national highway connecting Sarangani and Sultan Kudarat. Despite the extent of the impact, no casualties or evacuations were reported.</p> <p>On May 1, 2025, at approximately 4:30 PM, severe weather characterized by heavy rains and strong winds affected parts of Tacurong City. The incident caused structural damage, particularly in Barangays Baras and Rajah Muda, where several residential roofs were blown off.</p>

# Initial Report for the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Region XII

## ACTIONS TAKEN

### Region 12

#### **OCD XII**

- Continuously monitors and coordinates with concerned LGUs

#### **DSWD XII**

- Coordinated with affected LGUs for validation and data gathering of initial disaster data

#### **MDRRMO - Maitum**

- Deployed Quick Response Team (QRT) and RDANA team to conduct assessment on the reported incident caused by heavy rainfall
- Heavy equipment was deployed for clearing operations on reported landslide road
- Continuous monitoring of the situation in the affected areas

#### **CDRRMO – Tacurong**

- Coordinated with respective BDRRMCs for monitoring on the affected areas
- Conducted ocular inspection in the affected areas

#### **MDRRMO - Bagumbayan**

- Conducted assessment and validation of affected families
- Continuous monitoring on the situation in the affected areas
