# Initial Report for the Fire Incident in Port Area, Tondo, Manila City (NCR)

## ACTIONS TAKEN

### NCR

#### OCD NCR

- Continuously monitoring for updates

#### DSWD NCR

- The DSWD FO-NCR through the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) has conducted Rapid Disaster Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) on April 23, 2025. The team from DRMD is continuously coordinating with the Local Government Unit of Manila City through its Manila Department of Social Welfare as to updates and to provide resource augmentation and technical assistance needed; and

- Ensured the availability of food and non-food items for augmentation to the concerned Local Government Unit.

- The FO-NCR, through the DRMD facilitated the request for augmentation of food and non-food items of the LGU of Manila City through its MDSW and Cong. Irwin Tieng.

#### MANILA CITY DRRMO

##### Deployment and Response Efforts

- Manila DRRM Office deployed a fire suppression team and Two (2) firetrucks: Angel Tanker 4 and Angel Tanker 5
- Manila DRRM Office personnel have been deployed for information gathering.
- Manila DRRM Office deployed two (2) ambulance: LC3 and Covid 2 with Emergency Medical Team to take immediate action if there are any casualties who need to be treated.

##### Coordination

- Manila DRRM Office coordinated with the Bureau of Fire Protection Manila Fire District (BFP-MFD) for deployment of their fire suppression team.
- Fire volunteers have been alerted to take appropriate response actions.

##### Monitoring

- At 0003H of April 23, 2025 the Manila DRRM Office - Emergency Operations Center monitors a reported fire at Barangay 650, Port Area, Manila, through radio.
- As of 0004H, 1st Alarm was raised.
- Continuously coordinating with the personnel on scene for further details of the fire incident.
- As of 0005H, 2nd Alarm was raised.
- Continuously coordinating with the personnel on scene for further details of the fire incident.
- As of 0008H, 3rd Alarm was raised.
- As of 0009H, 4th Alarm was raised.
- As of 0016H, 5th Alarm was raised.
- Continuously coordinating with the personnel on scene for further details of the fire incident.
- As of 0025H, Task Force Alpha was raised.
- Close monitoring is being conducted at the Manila DRRM Office – Emergency Operations Center.
- At 0539H, Fire is Under Control.
- At 0659H, Fire is Out.
- From verification till fire out the fire sequence takes six (6) hours and fifty-six (56) minutes.
