OVERVIEW	On February 11, 2025 at around 9:53 AM, a vehicular accident transpired along Kalinga-Abra Road, Sitio Saleng, Balantoy, Balbalan, Kalinga. Based on the initial investigation, the Public Utility Jeep (PUJ) experienced brake malfunction causing the driver to lose control of the steering wheel. The vehicle veered off course and tumbled down the roadside.

-Coordinated with Balbalan MDRRMO, Kalinga PDRRMO and DOH-CHD CAR to verify and validate the details related to the incident.

**MDRRMC Balbalan**

- Coordinated and requested nearby municipalities for patient immediate transportation and referrals.
- Assisted KPH personnel at Emergency Room on patient care management and admissions
- Conducted and managed ambulance traffic flow on their designated lanes near the Emergency Room and guided ambulance drivers on their parking area.
- Traffic flow was managed to prevent further incidents in the area.
- Coordinated with the Provincial local authorities to ensure patient transportation and hospital referral.
