OVERVIEW	<p>Per DOH-RESU MIMAROPA Follow-Up Report No. 6, the increasing cases of dengue was detected on January 15, 2025 in Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro. As of March 18, 2025, a total of 205 cases was recorded with 5 deaths, 19 active cases and 181 recovered. During the Morbidity Week 02, a clustering of 40 dengue cases was recorded in different barangays.</p> <p>Distribution of cases:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Barangay Ligaya – 342. - Coordinated with DOH-RESU MIMAROPA re outbreak of dengue fever cases in Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro.

SABLAYAN MUNICIPAL DRRM OFFICE

- Activated Emergency Operations Center: Main Office, North and South for 24/7 operations monitoring.
- Activated Barangay Emergency Operations Center for 24/7 Operations monitoring
- Disseminated Public warnings/Advisories, Memorandum thru social media and other forms of communications.
- Activated of Blue Alert Status due to the Dengue and Measles Outbreak
- Issued MDRRMC Resolution No.2025-003, s 2025 dated March 10, 2025.
- Prepared and coordinated to Municipal Health Officer for health-related needs and personnel.
- Advised strict monitoring and reporting of hot spots area for impending weather disturbances and untoward incident.

SABLAYAN MUNICIPAL/RURAL HEALTH OFFICE

- Case management: Strict monitoring of dengue patients under home management and provision of Oresol for hydration and other medicines. Free Dengue Test (with token-insect repellent for all client who undergo testing)
- Field/epidemiologic investigation: Conducted active case finding and surveillance. Endorsed cases to the Doctor On Duty at RHU Main for further evaluation and management. Referred patients needing hospital care to SSDH.
- Continuous implementation of OPLAN TAOB weekly per barangay with documentation submitted to Vector Borne Program Manager for monitoring. Provision of Sumilarv to barangays with stagnant waters.
- The Dengue Focal Person of RHU (guided by the MHO) managed and supervised the implementation of countermeasures done in the barangay level, including OPLAN Linis/Taob, 4 o'clock habit and intensification of awareness campaigns in the barangays.
- Conducted misting operation in areas with clustering of cases.
- Intensification of awareness campaign is conducted to barangay level with the help of barangay midwives, BHWs and DOH HRH
- Conducted health information drive about dengue during PTA meetings
- Update the community of the case status of the municipality and discussed the prevention and management of dengue virus through radio broadcasting.
- Intensified IEC: Continuous conduct of health promotion and advocacy at the barangay level
- Conducted consultative meeting to identified Barangays with clustering of dengue cases to identify strategies to reverse the trend of Dengue Cases; discuss Dengue Preparedness and Response Checklist and Barangay Dengue Task Force; and the activation of Barangay Health Emergency Response Team.
- Proposed the declaration of dengue outbreak.

SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF SABLAYAN, OCCIDENTAL MINDORO

- Declared the outbreak of dengue by virtue of SB Resolution No. 2025-GGM525, dated March 11, 2025.
