Region 11

OCD-RDRRMC XI

- Continuous monitoring of AOR for possible augmentation of response teams and/or relief assistance;
- Continuous dissemination of EAWMs thru Social Media, Email, SMS, Messenger, Viber, and Radio Communications
- Continuous coordination with concerned agencies for deployment of requested logistical requirements to support the ongoing response operations/early recovery in affected areas within AOR .
- Aerial survey was conducted in 4 selected Mountain communities in Malita together with Officials and Personnel from OCD XI, MLGU Malita PLGU Davao Occidental Philippine Army and DSWD XI on December 29, 2024.
- Provided 1,107 Hygiene Kits to PDRRMO Davao Occidental on December 30, 2024.
- Coordinated with DOH regarding reported casualties of LGU Malita, for verification.

PDRRMO DAVAO OCCIDENTAL

- Provided relief assistance to the affected families inside evacuation centers.
- Raised its alert status to RED to intensify monitoring and coordination of LGUs and ensure timely mobilization of resources.
- Aerial survey was conducted in 4 selected Mountain communities in Malita together with Officials and Personnel from OCD XI, MLGU Malita PLGU Davao Occidental Philippine Army and DSWD XI on December 29, 2024.

MALITA, DAVAO OCCIDENTAL

- Coordination with the Municipal Engineering Office and barangay units for clearing operation.
- Continuous monitoring of weather updates from PAGASA and field assessments of critical areas
- Continuous dissemination of information to all residents, thru SMS and social media and Two -way radio.
- Continuous coordination with the BDRRMCs.
- Aerial survey was conducted in 4 selected Mountain communities in Malita together with Officials and Personnel from OCD XI, MLGU Malita PLGU Davao Occidental Philippine Army and DSWD XI on December 29, 2024.

SAN ISIDRO, DAVAO ORIENTAL

Conducted pre-emptive and forced evacuation.

JOSE ABAD SANTOS, DAVAO OCCIDENTAL

Constant monitoring and coordination with all barangays in relation to untoward incidents brought by persistent rainfall.
Conducted actual monitoring in the Fishing Village of Barangay Caburan Small in relation to the flooding incidence in the area.
Monitoring of weather conditions in all barangays as well dissemination of weather updates.

DON MARCELINO, DAVAO OCCIDENTAL

- Conducted monitoring of the AOR;

- Deployed MDRRMO Team for initial assessment of damages;
- Communicated and coordinated with BDRRMCs;
- Dissemination of weather advisories thru SMS, social media and email;
- Conducted ocular inspection of coastal areas;
- Conducted road and debris clearing operations by Municipal Engineering Office;
- Coordinated with MSWDO/CCCM Cluster for possible provision of relief assistance and identification of evacuation center;
- Provided initial relief assistance to affected barangays.

SANTA CRUZ, DAVAO DEL SUR

- Conducted monitoring of the AOR.

DPWH XI

- Conducted monitoring to affected roads and bridges;
- Conducted declogging of the canal and removal of debris in Brgy. Bato, Santa Cruz, Davao del Sur (Davao - Cotabato Road K1547+300 - K1547+450).
- Conducted clearing operations, filling of embankment materials and identification of alternate route in Malita, Davao Occidental (Lais Bridge 1);
- Conducted clearing operations and filling of embankment materials in Sitio Malaway, Brgy. Kinangan, Malita, Davao Occidental road (K1657+100 to K1657+200); and
- Conducted clearing operations in Baganga, Davao Oriental (S01389MN - Benigno S. Aquino Jr. National Highway).
- DPWH Malital provided dump trucks and manpower for the transport of Non Food items from OCD XI to PDRRMO Davao Occidental.
- In relation to the ongoing Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting the Davao Region, a Code White Alert status is hereby declared today, December 28, 2024. All relevant authorities and response teams are placed on stand-by mode, ready to respond promptly if necessary during the aforementioned period.
- Continuous monitoring and coordination with the PHO Davao Occidental and OCD XI for any updates and casualties.

DSWD XI

- The DSWD along with OCD and other agencies conducted an aerial survey to the affected areas in the Province of Davao Occidental.
- Personnel from the regional field office were deployed to assist LGU Malita in the management of their existing evacuation centers especially on their profiling and consolidation of gathered information.
- Distributed family foodpacks to the far-flung areas in Malita, Davao Occidental, these were airlifted through the Blackhawk of TOG11.
- Distributed family food packs to the affected families in Maco, Davao de Oro.
