OVERVIEW	<p>On 03 June 2025 at around 7:25 AM, a fire incident broke out in a residential unit at Little Tondo, Talaba 2 City of Bacoor, Cavite. The first alarm was raised at 07:40 AM, and raised to second alarm at 8:06 AM. The fire was under control at 8:29 AM and declared fire out at 8:41 AM.</p> <p>The City of Bacoor Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and other Fire Volunteers from the local agencies immediately responded to the scene. The cost of fire is under the investigation of the BFP.</p>

AFFECTED POPULATION

A total of 36 families or 118 persons were affected. Of which, 36 families or 118 persons were served inside 1 ECs and 0 families or 0 persons were served outside ECs:

ACTIONS TAKEN

CALABARZON

OCD CALABARZON

- Close coordination with Bacoor CDRRMO regarding the details of the incident and real-time updates
- Coordinated with BFP CALABARZON regarding the details of the incident
- Coordinated with DSWD and DOH CALABARZON for validation
- Continuous monitoring of situation in the affected LGU

BFP CALABARZON

- Provided initial information to OCD/RDRRMC EOC

BFP BACOR

- Immediately responded and ensured containment of the incident

BACOR CSWDO

- Provided initial information to Bacoor CDRRMC
- CSWD conducted interview to the affected families
- Setup modular tents
- Hot meals for lunch and dinner were serve to the affected individuals

BACOR CDRRMO

- Coordinated with the local BFP Bacoor, Cavite for immediate response
- Dispatched rescue teams to the incident
- Vigilant monitoring, reporting, and dissemination of the incident
- Bacoor DRRM Water tanker has been deployed to support the needs of water supply of firefighters
- Bacoor DRRM Medical Responders provide Emergency Medical Services to the displaced families of Baywatch Talaba 2 Fire Incident

BACOR CHO

- Conducted medical assistance to the affected individuals inside the evacuation center
