OVERVIEW	<p>On 16 March 2025, at around 2:30 PM, the Davao region experienced moderate to occasionally heavy rains caused by Easterlies. This resulted in flooding in Pantukan and Mabini, Davao de Oro.</p> <p>On 31 March 2025, at around 2:00 AM, an intense rainfall and strong winds brought by Easterlies has affected the Municipality of Don Marcelino, Davao Occidental. This resulted to flooding, damage to residential properties and critical infrastructures in some barangays of the municipality.</p>

Progress Report No. 1 on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao Region (Region XI)

ACTIONS TAKEN

Region 11

OCD XI

- Conducts monitoring of AOR to affected areas;
- Disseminates advisories thru email, social media, Viber and Messenger; and
- Conducted weather updating together with RDRRMC Member agencies and P/C/MDRRMOs.

DROMIC XI

- Maintains close coordination with provincial point person of DRMS Field Office XI for situation update; and
- Provided situational report to OCD XI.

PDRRMO Davao de Oro

- Coordinated with the BDRRMC and MDRRMC Operations Center for additional information regarding the incident;
- Monitored the weather and incidents through the 11 MDRRMC OPCEN for updates within respective area of responsibility;
- Monitored the MDRRMO's Facebook page for any class suspension and other related advisories;
- Dissemination of Thunderstorm Advisories, General Flood Advisories, Rainfall Advisories, and 24-hour Localized Weather Forecasts;
- Issuance of a Situational Report (SITREP) to the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) Region XI to provide them with relevant information and updates regarding the current situation; and
- Regular weather updates were consistently shared on social media for the general public.

MDRRMO Mabini

- WASAR team has been deployed to assist individuals in crossing the areas of Purok 6 – Cadunan, Purok 7 – Del Pilar and Migum – Cabuyoan due to unexpected heavy rainfall and rising water levels. However, no individuals or families have been evacuated or displaced, despite water levels rising to knee and waist height.
- Heavy equipment from the LGU was deployed to assist in clearing the flooded roads along Cuambog Hi-Way, which alleviated traffic congestion. Provincial and barangay roads remained passable;
- Continuous dissemination of weather updates via social media was done to the general public;
- Continuous monitoring of the AOR was conducted through the BDRRM's focal person via the messenger app;
- MDRRMO Mabini Operations Center continued to monitor the Area of Responsibility (AOR); and
- Conducted ocular inspection of the landslide incident at Sitio Magpalusong.

MDRRMO Pantukan

- Deployment of teams for ocular inspection on low-lying areas;
- Distributed relief goods to the affected families together with MSWDO; and
- Conducted RDANA to all affected barangays.

MDRRMO Don Marcelino

- BDRRMC conducted rapid assessment to the affected areas and provided updates to MDRRMO
- Conducted clearing operations initiated by MDRRMO
- MEO initiated immediate inspection and conducted repair of the damaged culvert concrete road in Sitio Catigbao, Talaguton together with our stakeholder, TADECO-ABC.
- DPWH conducted debris clearing along the National Highway to ensure the passage of vehicles.
- Coordinated with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) for the

provision of immediate relief assistance to affected families.

- Distributed relief packs to the affected HHs in Sitio Pamongot.
- Coordinated with DASURECO for the immediate restoration of electric power
- Conducted continuous monitoring and dissemination of advisories to the community
