OVERVIEW	<p>On or about 3:30pm, May 11, 2025, a flashflood incident occurred in some Barangays of Maragusan, Davao de Oro due to continuous moderate to heavy rains caused by Easterlies.</p> <p>On or about 2:00PM, 18 May 2025, landslide and flooding incidents occurred at Don Marcelino, Malita, Jose Abad Santos due to the effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).</p> <p>On or about 6:00PM, 19 May 2025, flooding occurred at various areas in Davao City due to moderate to heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ.</p> <p>On or about 5:00PM, 25 May 2025, street flooding occurred at different areas in Davao City and Municipality of Maco, Davao de Oro due to moderate at times heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ.</p> <p>On or about 3:40pm, May 31, 2025, a flooding and landslide incidents occurred in the Municipalities of New Bataan and Maragusan, Davao de Oro due to continuous moderate to heavy rains caused by localized thunderstorms.</p> <p>Due to overlapping effects of Easterlies, Intertropical Convergence Zone and Localized Thunderstorms in Davao Region, and in consonance to the NDRRMC Memorandum re Merging Incident and Situational Reports for Multiple Hazards, the OCD-RDRRMC XI together with concerned Local DRRMCs have agreed to have it reported as Combined Effects of Easterlies, Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) and Localized Thunderstorms.</p>
