OVERVIEW	On 06 March 2025, at around 9:40 PM, a magnitude 4.9 earthquake occurred in Wao, Lanao del Sur, with reported Intensity V, which was felt in various areas. This resulted in damage to houses and infrastructure. Subsequently, another earthquake occurred on 08 March 2025, with a magnitude of 5.1, a depth of focus of 10 km, and tectonic in origin. This earthquake is expected to cause further damage and aftershocks. As of 10 March 2025, at 8:00 AM, PHIVOLCS had recorded 37 aftershocks.

Progress Report No. 2 for the Effects of Magnitude 5.1 Earthquake in Wao, Lanao del Sur (BARMM) ACTIONS TAKEN

BARMM

OCD-BAR

- OCD BAR coordinated with MDRRMO of Municipality of Wao and PDRRMO Lanao del Sur re: the incident.
- The Office of Civil Defense BAR operations center activated its Blue Alert status in support to the recent earthquake incident in Wao, Lanao del Sur for the continous monitoring and assessment of the situation.
- OCD BAR is in continuous monitoring 24/7 at the Operations Center.

PDDRMO-LDS

- Coordination and conduct of joint assessment with MDRRMO Wao re effects of earthquake and aftershocks in the affected areas.
- The Municipal Government of Wao through its Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office immediately monitored and deployed Emergency Response Team.
- Dissemination of earthquake information by the PHIVOLCs and the Provincial DRRM Office of Lanao del Sur and Wao DRRM Office.
- The Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office of Lanao del Sur together with Wao Municipal DRRM Office conducted rapid assessment in the Municipality on the morning of 08 March 2025.
- Assessment and validation of damages especially to residential houses continues.

MDRRMO Wao

- Submitted report to OCD BAR Opcen.
- In close coordination with PDRRMO- LDS in the conduct of joint assessment in the affected areas.
- Still conducting further assessment and validation to the concerned government facilities including public and private schools, particularly on the estimated cost of damage.
- As of March 13, 2025, assisted the Engineering office on the ongoing validation and assessment on the reported damages in barangays.

PNP Engineering Service:

- Technical personnel from this unit together with WAO LGU Engineering Office and WAO MDRRMO conducted a joint site inspection and assessment to some affected facilities, especially the WAO Municipal Police Station Building.
- As of March 13, 2025, ongoing validation and assessment were conducted by the Engineering office with MDRRM personnel on the reported damages in barangays stated above. It is expected that the assessment team will continue its validation to determine the exact number of houses affected by the earthquake.
