OVERVIEW	On 27 April 2025 at around 11:34PM, a residential fire broke out at Badjaoan, Brgy. Malitam, Batangas City, Batangas. First alarm was raised at 11:49 PM, and was raised to the 2nd alarm at 12:17 AM on 28 April 2025. The fire was declared under control at around 12:21 AM and was declared fire out at 12:15 AM. Investigation reveals that the fire originated from food left unattended while cooking, which ignited nearby flammable materials and rapidly spread due to the structure of the dwellings.

Progress Report No. 1 for the Fire Incident in Brgy. Malitam, Batangas City, Batangas (CALABARZON) ACTIONS TAKEN

CALABARZON

OCD CALABARZON

- -Close coordination with Batangas PDRRMO and Batangas City DRRMO regarding the details of the incident and real-time updates
- -Coordinated with BFP CALABARZON re the details of the incident
- -Continuous monitoring of situation in the affected LGU

BFP CALABARZON

-Provided initial information to OCD/RDRRMC EOC

PDRRMO BATANGAS

- -Provided initial information to OCD/RDRRMC EOC
- -Continuous monitoring of situation in the affected LGU

CDRRMC BATANGAS

- -Coordinated with BFP Batangas City for immediate response
- -Vigilant monitoring, reporting, and dissemination of the incident
- -Coordinated with CSWD for camp management
- -City Social Welfare and Development Office conducted the validation and provided the immediate needs (food packs, jerry cans, and hygiene kits) of the affected families
- -CSWDO, CDRRMO and BDRRMC established and managed the community kitchen to provide hot meals to the affected families
- -ABDRRMO provided assistance in the management of the community kitchen
- -Philippine Red Cross Batangas Chapter assessed the condition of the affected families and provided jerry cans, drinking water, and sleeping kits
- -PNP and BDRRMC continuously provide security services in the area to ensure the safety and security of the affected families
- -CDRRMO coordinated with Primewater Batangas City for the provision of water supply to the affected families
- -CDRRMO conducts continuous monitoring of the condition of the affected families and coordinates with the concerned agencies to address needs and concerns

CHO BATANGAS

- -Coordination with local DRRM regarding status of the incident and possible augmentation of DRRM-H Staff
- -Activation of HERT for two nearby Barangay Wawa and Malitam
- -Coordinated HEPO for information dissemination of health impacts of the fire incident
- -Coordinated to Barangay Disaster officer for the status of the evacuation center
