OVERVIEW	<ul> <li>On or about 7:00pm, 28 June 2025, a flashflood occurred in Brgy. Katipunan, Nabunturan, Davao de Oro due to heavy rains caused by Southwest Monsoon affecting Davao Region.</li> <li>On or about 2:47pm, 29 June 2025, a landslide incident occurred in Sitio Tandik, Brgy. Katipunan, Maragusan, Davao de Oro. While on or about 5:00pm of the same date, a flashflood incident occurred in Barangays Panoraon and Mainit, Maco, Davao de Oro due to moderate to heavy rains caused still caused by Southwest Monsoon.</li> <li>On 1 and 2 July 2025, landslides occurred in Barangays Tubaon and Cabagayan, respectively, due to several days of occasional heavy rainfall brought by the Southwest Monsoon affecting Tarragona, Davao Oriental.</li> <li>On or about 3:30 AM on 6 July 2025, flooding was reported in Barangays Nangan and</li> </ul>
	Pundaguitan, Governor Generoso, Davao Oriental. On the same day, at 5:00 am, a mudslide incident occurred in Brangay Saladoc, Don Marcelino, Davao Occidental caused by moderate to heavy rains associated with the Southwest Monsoon.

# Region 11

# OCD XI

- Continuous monitoring of AOR in coordination with P/C/MDRRMCs and concerned RDRRMC XI memberagencies;

- Continuous dissemination of EAWMs thru Social Media, SMS, and E-mail; and
- Continuous coordination with affected LGUs for possible provision of NFI and Rice Assistance.

# **DSWD XI DROMIC**

- Maintained close coordination with the affected LGUs;
- Coordinated with OCD XI re significant information related to the Southwest Monsoon; and
- Maintains adequate supply of stockpile ready for augmentation.

## DPWH XI

- Continuous monitoring of affected infrastructure;
- Installed warning signs and traffic; and
- Conducted clearing operation

## **Don Marcelino MDRRMO**

- Continuous monitoring of the AOR;
- MDRRMO personnel were deployed for response and monitoring of the incident area;

- Assisted the stranded pedestrian in Barangay Saladoc;- MEO and DPWH conducted clearing and temporary stabilization of affected roads;

- Traffic control and signage were installed in the hazardous locations;
- Power outage and restoration were coordinated with the local electric cooperative;
- Public advisories disseminated through official channels and social media;
- The LGU provided housing materials to families with partially damaged houses;
- Distributed food packs to affected families;
- Coordinated with the CIU-Davao Occidental to assist families with damaged homes;
- Coordinated with DASURECO to help restore electricity in the Municipality;

- Continuous dissemination of weather and road updates, along with safety reminders, through their official social media accounts; and

- Ongoing assessment of damaged houses, crops and roads.

# **Davao Oriental PDRRMO**

- Conducted monitoring of the AOR;
- Continuous dissemination of weather advisories;
- Prepositioned response personnel and equipment if needs arises; and
- Conducted close coordination with their respective MDRRMOs,

# Davao De Oro P/MDRRMCs

- Davao de Oro PDRRMO on continuous monitoring of AOR in coordination with MDRRMCs and concerned PDRRMC member-agencies/offices;

- Coordinated with Provincial Engineering Office for the conduct of clearing operations in the landslide affected areas;

- Continuous dissemination of EAWMs thru Social Media, Radio Communication and SMS;

- Continuous coordination with affected LGUs for possible augmentation of assistance

- Maco, Maragusan and Nabunturan on continuous monitoring of respective AOR in coordination with BDRRMCs;

- Maco, Maragusan and Nabunturan conducted clearing operations of their respective AORs affected by flashflood and landslide incidents; and

- Conducted clearing operation in Barangay Anitapan, Pantukan.

#### **Governor Generoso MDRRMO**

- Provided relief operation conducted by MSWDO;
- Conducted evacuation of affected residents;
- Conducted clearing operation;
