OVERVIEW	<p>On 15 May 2025, at 5:00 PM, a moderate to heavy rainfall brought by the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) occurred in the Municipality of Alamada, Province of Cotabato. This resulted in flashfloods and landslides in some barangays of Alamada.</p> <p>On May 18, 2025, at around 01:00 AM, the Municipality of Alabel, Sarangani, Tantaran, South Cotabato and Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat experienced heavy rainfall brought by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).</p> <p>On May 19, 2025, at around 04:00 PM, the Municipality of Sto. Niño, South Cotabato also experienced heavy rainfall brought by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).</p> <p>On May 20, 2025, at around 02:30 PM, the Municipality of Malapatan, Sarangani experienced continuous heavy rainfall brought Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) which resulted to flooding incident in Brgy. Tuyan.</p> <p>On May 20, 2025, a drowning incident transpired in Brgy. Mapurok, Alamada, Province of Cotabato, attributed to ITCZ. The said victim was crossing the river, and was swept away due to the strong current.</p> <p>On May 22, 2025 at around 5PM, 2 brgys of Maitum, Sarangani Province, experienced moderate to heavy rainfall brought about by ITCZ resulting to flashflood.</p> <p>On May 23, 2025 at around 8:30 am, Brgy Poblacion, Carmen, Cotabato Province experienced heavy rainfall brought about by ITCZ resulting to flashflood.</p>

ACTIONS TAKEN**

Region 12

LGU Lambayong

- Immediately responded to the incident.
- Deployed Lambayong Rescue Team
- Continuous monitoring and coordination with the barangay affected.

LGU Maitum

- Conduct Rapid Damage Assessment and Need Analysis (RDANA)
- Immediately responded to the incident.

LGU Carmen

- Conduct Rapid Damage Assessment and Need Analysis (RDANA)

LGU Pikit

- RDANA Team conducted monitoring, assessment and validation
- Provided basic medical assistance and potable water to flooded households
- Provided public awareness for possible evacuation and preparation for possible flashfloods
- Continuous monitoring to the affected Barangays

LGU Lebak

- Local Government provided for expenses for the funeral services of the reported casualties.
- Food packs totally 564 packs were given to the affected families in Brgy Salaman.
- Continuous monitoring to the affected Barangays as of reporting

LGU Kalamansig

- Conduct search and rescue operation
- Provided hot meals to the IDPs in the evening of May 23, 2025
- Conducted RDANA
- Continuous monitoring to the affected Barangays yesterday night until this time

LGU Senator Ninoy Aquino

- Conducted clearing operations and continuous monitoring to the affected Barangays

LGU Sto. Niño

- Conducted an ocular inspection to the affected area
- Continuous monitoring and coordination with the barangays affected.

LGU Malapatan

- MDRRMO staff conducted initial inspection in the area for assessment
- Immediately responded to the scene and transported the victim to Sarangani Provincial Hospital
- Continuous coordination with respective BDRRMCs and monitoring of the situation.

LGU Alabel

- Coordinated Alabel Rescue Team (ART) for continuous monitoring on the affected areas.
- Conduct Rapid Damage Assessment and Need Analysis (RDANA)

LGU Tantangan

- Immediately responded to the incident.
- Provided Food and Non Food Items to the affected families.
- Continuous monitoring and coordination with the barangays affected.

LGU Alamada

- Conduct Rapid Damage Assessment and Need Analysis (RDANA)
- Conduct Clearing Operation
- Coordinated with respective BDRRMCs for monitoring on the affected areas
- Ongoing Monitoring and Coordination with concern agencies
- MDRRM Libungan Conducted search and retrieval operation in the AOR.
