ACTIONS TAKEN

Region 11

OCD XI

- Continuous monitoring of AOR for possible augmentation of response teams and/or relief assistance.
- Continuous dissemination of EAWMs thru social media, Email, SMS, Messenger, Viber, and Radio Communications.

JOSE ABAD SANTOS, DAVAO OCCIDENTAL

Monitoring of weather conditions in all barangays as well dissemination of weather updates.

MONKAYO, DAVAO DE ORO

- Conducted Debris Clearing on Landslide Area Purok 22 Brgy. Mt. Diwata
- MDRRMO Responder on 24/7 duty
- Monitored all BDRRMC's
- Conducted water level monitoring
- Constant monitoring to DOST-PAGASA Weather Forecast and Advisories; and
- Constant dissemination of weather updates through social media and Radio Broadcasting.

MONTEVISTA, DAVAO DE ORO

Issued suspension of classes.

COMPOSTELA, DAVAO DE ORO

- January 15, 2025 Suspension of Classes;
- Continuous monitoring of low lying areas and landslide prone areas;
- Information dissemination to different respective barangays on the present weather system;
- Suspension of face to face classes in all levels both public and private schools and work in all School institutions; and
- Monitoring of river and creek water levels.
- A minor landslide was reported at Prk. 16, Poblacion, Mawab. The MDRRMO Mawab team was dispatched to the area, and it was cleared.

NEW BATAAN, DAVAO DE ORO

- Classes were suspended on January 15, 2025.
- Monitored the assigned area of responsibility.
- Continuously tracked weather conditions and provided updates.

MACO, DAVAO DE ORO

- MDRRMO personnel were activated.
- Heavy equipment and assets were prepositioned.
- Barangays prone to flooding and landslides were closely monitored.
- Weather updates were disseminated to the public via VHF radio, social media (Facebook), and messenger.

LAAK, DAVAO DE ORO

- Weather updates were continuously disseminated to all MDRRMCs, BDRRMCs, stakeholders, and SDRRM coordination through SMS, social media, and messenger accounts.
- Close monitoring and coordination with BDRRMCs were conducted, advising all barangays to monitor their areas, especially low-lying areas susceptible to floods and landslides.
- The MDRRMO Operations Center conducted 24/7 monitoring of the Area of Responsibility (AOR) for any potential effects. Standby personnel and response equipment were prepared for possible responses, and all resources were inventoried.
- Water level monitoring was carried out at Logdeck River, Amoracruz, Laak.
- No pre-disaster incidents were reported within the municipality as part of the monitoring efforts.

PDRRMC Davao Oriental

- Conducted continuous monitoring and dissemination of weather advisories and information;
- Conducted continuous coordination with LDRRMOs
- Prepositioned resources for possible augmentation

PDRRMC Davao de Oro

- Closely coordinated with the BDRRMC and MDRRMC Operations Center for additional information regarding the incident.
- The MDRRMO of Monkayo was informed that heavy equipment is available in the Unggoyan area awaiting their update if they need any augmentation. - Continuously monitored the weather and any incident thru the 11 MDRRMC OPCEN for updates within their AOR (Area of Responsibility).
- Monitored the MDRRMO's Facebook page for any class suspension and other related advisories. As of 0800H on January 15, 2025.

DSWD XI

- Coordinated with the MDRRMO Santa Maria to ensure that protection mechanisms are in place while IDPs are temporarily staying in the evacuation center;
- coordinated with the MDRRMO in monitoring the status of IDPS inside evacuation centers and continuously provides technical assistance on CCCM and IDP Protection; and
- Maintained close coordination with the MDRRMOs for any significant updates.
