# Progress Report No. 1 for the Effects of Shear Line in Bicol Region (Region V)

## ACTIONS TAKEN

### Region 5

#### OCD V

- Bicol RDRRMC Operations Center is on BLUE Alert status for Shearline;
- On-going coordination with LDRRMOs and NGAs for the effects of the Shearline;
- Mobilities are on standby in case of deployment;
- Radio communications and SATELLITE PHONE on standby.
- Accommodated media interviews.
- Disseminated Weather Forecasts, Rainfall Warnings, Rainfall Advisories, MGB Advisories and other weather-related issuances to the LGUs and the General Public.

#### DSWD V

- DSWD FO V is close coordinating with the LGUs through P/C/MSWAD and DRMD Focals on the request for augmentation of FNFIs
- Ensured the safety and protection of IDPs evacuated due to floodings particularly Women and Children, and the visibility of the LGUs & BLGU security personnel and other CMTs.
- DSWD FO V, through its DRMD, Regional QRTs, and SWAD Team Leaders maintained close monitoring of weather updates and other pertinent information through all available sources.
- Response Cluster has been activated to streamline coordination and implement emergency operations. Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is fully operational, facilitating round-the-clock response efforts.
- RD, DSWD5 Issued directives to the Response and Action Teams to closely monitor their respective Areas of Responsibility and coordinate with Local Government Units (LGUs).

#### DILG V

- Issued Regional Order No. 2025-009 re Regional EOC and Disaster Monitoring in view of Shearline
- Issued Memorandum to all Provincial Directors and concerned LGOOs to continuously coordinate with the respective DRRMCs, prepare actions for High Risk Areas with emphasis on activation of EOC, IMTs and implementation of Operation L!STO Protocols and DILG MC 2024-074
- Continuous coordination with LDRRMCs

#### PAGASA Southern Luzon

- Provision of weather and rainfall updates/advisories including localized weather updates to the Regional and local DRRMCs and other stakeholders.
- Continuous weather monitoring.

#### DENR-MGB V

- Activated the MGB5 Geohazards Operations Center
- Issued Regional Geohazard Threat Advisory for Shearline for the Regional DRRMC – OCD Bicol Region detailing the cumulative forecast rainfall with recommended actions for LGUs (emphasizing the landslide susceptibility)
- Issued Landslide Warning Bulletin No. 1 dated 08 January 2025 6:00PM for Shearline detailing the cumulative forecast rain and its warning levels.

## **DPWH V**

- Coordinated with OCD5 for the status of affected national roads and bridges in the Region through submission of Situation Report;
- DPWH Teams are deployed in along the national roads performing manual clearing and declogging of drainage, gutter and inlets, manual removal of debris in affected areas;
- Continuous monitoring of road sections.

## **PDRRMC Albay**

Issued PDRRMC-APSEMO Advisory 2025-02 effective tomorrow 09 January 2025:

- Reiteration of localized suspension of face-to-face classes.
- Work arrangements
- Resumption of work: Work shall resume for employees of government and private agencies/offices who are not affected by floods, landslides, or lahar flow.
- Work-from-home provisions: Employees affected by floods of at least 60 cm (knee level), making roads impassable to light vehicles, including PUVs, PUJs, tricycles, and other light vehicles, are allowed to work from home.
- Evacuation orders: Local Government Units (LGUs) may execute evacuations as needed in areas prone to flooding, landslides, and lahar flow.
- Restriction of small sea crafts: No sailing of small sea crafts.
- River crossing Prohibition: No crossing of swollen rivers.
- Monitoring and standby: All Local Government Units – C/MDRRMO must be on standby and closely monitor weather bulletins from PAGASA.

Issued PDRRMC-APSEMO Advisory 2025-01 re order for disaster avoidance and public safety;

- Reiteration of the localized suspension of face-to-face classes today.
- Early dismissal of work in all government offices in Albay, except for agencies involved in public safety, disaster risk reduction, health, and related services, effective at 12NN, 8 January 2025.
- Employees who are unable to report to work shall be excused.
- Private agencies/offices are encouraged to consider early dismissal at the discretion of their respective heads or employers.
- LGUs may execute evacuation as needed to areas prone to flooding, landslide, and lahar flow.
- No sailing of small sea crafts. No crossing on swollen rivers.
- All Local Government Units – C/MDRRMO are to standby and closely monitor the weather bulletins by PAGASA.

## **PDRRMC Camarines Sur**

- Issued Memorandum regarding Suspension of Face to Face Classes and Work in Schools at all levels (Public and Private).
- Close monitoring and dissemination of weather advisories to LDRRMCs and the general public;
- Close coordination with PDRRMC Members and C/MDRRMOs re situations in their respective area of responsibility (AOR).
- Resources and personnel on standby ready for deployment.

## **PDRRMC Sorsogon**

- Continuous monitoring and updates on Weather and Bulusan Volcano and dissemination of information obtained from DOST – PAGASA and DOST – PHIVOLCS regarding the weather updates and Bulusan Volcano bulletin to SPDRRMC Members/C/MDRRMCs, the public and concerned persons thru Broadcast, social media, Infoboard and Infosys;
- Monitoring and coordination with Blue Lane Marshall and authorities for the status and management of traffic along Matnog Maharlika Highway;
- SPDRRRMO conducted Search and Rescue on the flooded areas in Brgy. Salog, Sorsogon City;

- Ensure clear lines of communication with all C/MDRRMOs for updates and coordination;
- Operation Center on heightened alert;
- Conducted relief distribution to the affected families in the evacuation centers;
