OVERVIEW	<p>On February 19, 2025, at 05:00 AM, PAGASA issued a Heavy Rainfall Warning for Mindanao due to Easterlies affecting the Caraga region. Surigao Del Norte (Claver) and Surigao Del Sur (City of Tandag, Carmen, Madrid, Cortes, Cantilan, Lanuza, and Carrascal) were placed under a Yellow Warning.</p> <p>On February 21, 2025, at 5:00 AM, Northern Mindanao, Caraga, Zamboanga Peninsula, and Davao Oriental experienced cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms due to the Shearline. A Yellow Warning was issued for Surigao Del Norte (Socorro, Siargao Island, Claver), Surigao Del Sur (Carmen, Lanuza, Madrid, Cortes, Cantilan, Tandag, Carrascal), and Dinagat Islands.</p> <p>On February 22, 2025, Mindanao experienced cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms caused by the Easterlies. Light to moderate rains were experienced over Surigao Del Sur (Barobo) and Agusan Del Sur (San Francisco).</p> <p>On February 26, 2025, Northern Mindanao and Caraga experienced cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and isolated thunderstorms due to the Shearline.</p> <p>On February 27, 2025, Caraga experienced light to moderate rains over Agusan Del Sur (San Luis, Talacogon, San Francisco, Bayugan, Prosperidad, Esperanza), Surigao Del Sur (Bayabas, Tago, Tandag, Cortes, Lanuza, San Miguel), and Agusan Del Norte (Las Nieves).</p> <p>Currently, the Caraga region is experiencing cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms due to the Shearline.</p>

- 24/7 weather and water level monitoring Operations and Warning Division of PDRRMO;
- Info dissemination to all C/MDRRMOs through email and social media platform (FB Messenger) for widest dissemination to their respective AORs;
- Follow up calls and text messages by PDRRM Officer to all MDRRMOs re precautionary measures;
- Prepositioning of rescue equipment, water assets, rescue vehicles, ambulances and responders;
- Prepositioning of relief goods;
- DRRMO responders and SRR Team (AFP, 544TH ENG'G BDE and PNP) on standby alert and ready for deployment;
- Issued advisory to C/MDRRM Councils and PDRRMC Member Agencies;
- Conducted on-site water level monitoring to some low-lying areas in San Francisco and Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur;
- PSWDO conducted monitoring of affected individuals/families, evacuation center status, etc. in coordination with C/MSWDOs;
- PNP and SAF Response Teams are on standby for possible deployment;
- Issuance of advisory on lifting the suspension of classes in all level, both public and private within the province;
- Consolidated and submitted SitRep to OCD Regional Office.

CDRRMO Surigao City

- Conducted intensive weather condition monitoring;
- Conducted water level and rainfall monitoring;
- Closely monitors and coordinated with the BLGUs;

- Prepositioning of heavy equipment, assets and human resources;
- Conducted clearing operations to remove fallen trees;
- Conducted rescue operations to evacuate residents due to rising floodwaters in Sitio Togonan and Purok 4, Brgy. Mabini.

MDRRMO Sison
