# Progress Report No. 2 for the Effects of Shear Line in MIMAROPA

## ACTIONS TAKEN

### MIMAROPA

#### OCD MIMAROPA

- Ensure close coordination with response agencies, OCD MIMAROPA Field Officers and concerned LGUs re situation updates for the effects of Shear Line.
- Dissemination of advisories, bulletins and MBG List to RDRRMC member agencies and LDRRMOs and posted same to Official OCD Social Media Accounts.
- Ensure functionality of all available communication equipment and sufficient supply of NFIs
- Monitor closely Weather Advisories, General Flood Advisories and other advisories issued by DOST PAGASA, DENR-MGB and other surveillance agencies.

#### PDRRMO Palawan

- Activation of Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Blue Alert to Strengthen coordination with all Municipal DRRMCs and encourage them to place their Emergency Operation Centers on Blue Alert status to continuously monitor their respective AORs.
- Disseminate timely situational reports and updates through text messages, email, and other means of communication to Palawan PDRRMC Member Agencies & MIMAROPA RDRRMC.
- Dissemination of Public Weather Advisories as needed.
- Continued monitoring of PAGASA advisories and other issuances and situations in all municipalities.
- Conduct inventory & accounting of available supplies.
- Standby of response equipment, vehicles, & teams for possible deployment.
- Coordination with the Response Cluster, DRR Volunteers and municipal counterparts.
- Conduct functionality checks of equipment.

#### CDRRMC Puerto Princesa City

- Activation of 24/7 Emergency Operations Center to coordinate response and safety measures and status monitoring regarding the effects Inter Tropical Convergence Zone Affecting Palawan and Puerto Princesa City.
- Coordination with response cluster member agencies.
- Dissemination of DOST PAGASA Weather Advisories through social media.
- Monitoring of water levels of rivers and in low-lying areas.
- Ensuring availability of food and non-food items at EOC – main warehouse and 4 forward warehouses at mini city hall.
- Deployed standby response team to Forward EOCs.
- Real-time flood water level, river and rainfall monitoring through installed Local Flood Early Warning devices and Automated Weather Stations.
- On stand-by CDRRMO response teams with equipment and gears.
- Coordinated with Philippine Coast Guard, Bureau of Fire Protection, Puerto Princesa City - Police Office, Marine Battalion Landing Team 9 (MBLT9), DPWH, City Engineering, regarding rescue operations due to weather disturbance due to inter tropical convergence zone affected areas.
- Dissemination of memorandum regarding Activation of EOC Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting PPC.
- EOC Manager together with City Information Office (CIO), Responsible Official/CDRRMC Chairperson, CSWD, DOST-Pagasa PPC, City Engineering Department, conducted a press briefing regarding the current situation of Puerto Princesa City due to ITCZ held at EOC conference room via Facebook live.
- EOC Manager and EOC Coordinators conducted operational briefing with the EOC personnel and coordinating and assisting agencies.

#### MDRRMCs/LDRRMOs Palawan

- Continuously monitor situations in their respective AORs.
- Provide necessary (medical/vehicle) assistance.
- Preposition of emergency responders.
- Place rescue vehicles on standby mode.
- Provide periodic situational reports to PDRRMO.
- Coordination with local DRR Volunteers for reporting of Incidents and Possible Deployment.
- Continuous monitoring and close coordination with barangays.
