**Progress Report No. 01 for the Maritime Incident in Rizal, Occidental Mindoro (MIMAROPA)**

OVERVIEW	<p>On 15 April 2025, around 5:20 PM, the MV "Hong Hai 16", a sand carrier vessel owned by Keen Peak Corporation, with 25 crew members onboard (13 Filipinos and 12 Chinese Nationals) reportedly capsized approximately 100 meters off the shoreline of Barangay Malawaan, Rizal, Occidental Mindoro.</p> <p>The capsized vessel has a gross tonnage of 9,994 and a net tonnage of 3,002. It was carrying approximately 2,000 liters of lube oil and 30,000 liters of Automotive Diesel Oil (ADO).</p> <p>The incident was initially reported via phone call to Coast Guard Sub Station San Jose, Occidental Mindoro from a staff of Bantay Dagat Rizal.</p> <p>On 16 April 2025, around 2:30 PM, Coast Guard divers located and recovered the lifeless body of a Filipino crew member from the bridge area of the vessel. The next day, Special Operations Unit – Southern Tagalog (SOU-STL) divers have recovered another lifeless body from the accommodation area below the bridge of the capsized vessel. and another body was found at the cabin located at the main deck of the vessel.</p> <p>Out of the 25 crew members onboard, 14 were rescued, three (3) were found dead, one (1) died at the hospital, and seven (7) are still missing.</p> <p>Sources: PDRRMO OCCIDENTAL MINDORO, PCGSTL, and PCG Official Facebook Page</p>

# Progress Report No. 01 for the Maritime Incident in Rizal, Occidental Mindoro (MIMAROPA)

## ACTIONS TAKEN

### MIMAROPA

#### OCD MIMAROPA

- Conducted courtesy call and meeting with PCG Southern Tagalog to discuss the status of SAR Operations for missing crew members
- Continuous coordination with PCG Southern Tagalog and PDRRMO Occidental Mindoro on the status and reporting of SAR Operations
- Coordination with RDRRMC Member Agencies Response Cluster to address the needs of the response teams

#### PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD DISTRICT SOUTHERN TAGALOG

- Continuous conduct of SAR Operations for missing crew of said vessel
- Deployed oil spill boom around the overturned vessel
- Deployment of BRP Malabrigo (MRRV 4402) to assist ongoing operations

#### PDRRMO OCCIDENTAL MINDORO

- Continuous conduct of SAR Operations and monitoring within the vicinity of the incident with personnel from MDRRMO Rizal, BDRRMC Malawaan, BFP, PNP, MENRO, PCG and Phil. Army
- Continuous monitoring and coordination re Maritime Incident in Rizal, Occidental Mindoro.
- Coordinated with Philippine Coast Guard Station Occidental Mindoro re Maritime Incident in Rizal, Occidental Mindoro.
- Established Incident Management Team re Maritime Incident in Rizal, Occidental Mindoro.
