OVERVIEW	On 06 December 2024, the Shear Line impacted the eastern part of Northern Luzon, while the Northeast Monsoon affected the Extreme Northern Regions of the Island. As a result, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and isolated thunderstorms were experienced in parts of Batanes, Cagayan, Isabela, Quirino, and Nueva Vizcaya.
