OVERVIEW	On March 4, 2025, an increase in Dengue cases was observed in the cities of Imus, Dasmariñas, and General Trias, Cavite. Imus City reported deaths due to Dengue, and all three cities were placed under a state of calamity due to the significant number of cases.
