-Monitored the terminal report update

DSWD-NCR

- -As of reporting time, the DSWD FO-NCR through the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) is continuously coordinating with the Local Government Unit of Valenzuela City through its CSWDO as to updates and augmentation assistance needed; and
- -The DSWD FO NCR through the DRMD has provided 70 Family Food Packs, 70 Hygiene Kits, 70 Sleeping Kits, and 70 Kitchen Kits to the affected families through the directives of Secretary Rex T. Gatchalian on March 22, 2025. Each Family Food Pack costs Php 689.00, and each Hygiene Kit costs Php 1,288.00, each Sleeping Kit costs Php 1,240.00 and each Kitchen Kits costs Php 1,607.20; and
- -Ensured the availability of food and non-food items for augmentation to the concerned Local Government Unit.
- -As per coordination with the Local Government Unit of Valenzuela City, their CSWDO will provide any assistance needed by the affected families.
